World Population Day

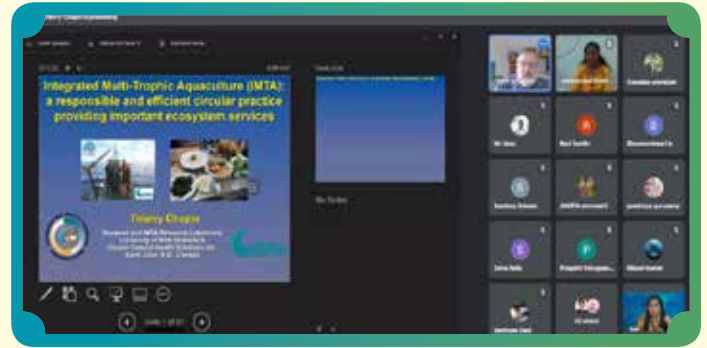

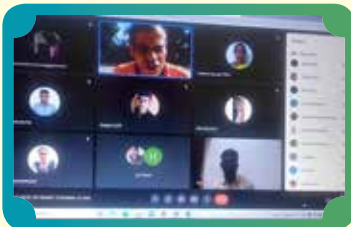
College of Fisheries Engineering National fish farmers day 2021

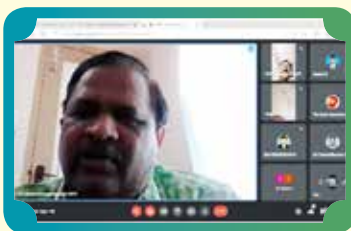

Patent Granted:

A patent entitled "Designing of genus-specific primer for Lutjanus from 16s rRNA mitochondrial region for authentication of snapper products by single-step PCR" was granted to the research team, Prof. G. Jeyasekaran, Dr. B. Sivaraman and Prof. R. Jeya Shakila of the Department of Fish Quality Assurance and Management, Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi. The patent was granted for designing a genus-specific primer set, 6S-SGS-F/16S-SGS-R, targeting 16S rRNA region of snapper belonging to the genus Lutjanus. The specificity of the primer was proven with six snappers species of Lutjanus. The primer set did not amplify the target region of three related selected groups viz., groupers, emperors and tilapia. The technique will be useful for direct authentication of raw and processed snappers by single-step PCR, as snapper is one of the major fish species adulterated in the International market.
